Re: Appeal Of OMB FOIA 2016-096 Denial

Dear Ms. Hardy:

This is in reference to the above Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) by my client, the American Center for Equitable Treatment, Inc. (American Center), a copy of which is attached for your convenience.

The American Center appeals because OMB has failed to respond to this request as required by law. See 5 U.S.C. 552(a); CREW v. Federal Election Commission, 711 F.3d 180, 188 (D.C. Cir. 2013). This failure is actionable in its own right and also as a wrongful denial of a valid FOIA request. See, e.g., id; see also 5 U.S.C. 706.

Also, although the American Center is entitled to a fee waiver as a matter of law, OMB has waived the right to claim fees and therefore need not address this issue in its impending response. An agency that fails to comply with any FOIA time limit forfeits its authority to assess fees. 5 U.S.C. §552(a)(4)(A)(viii).
